## Advance's Criminal Justice Service offers:

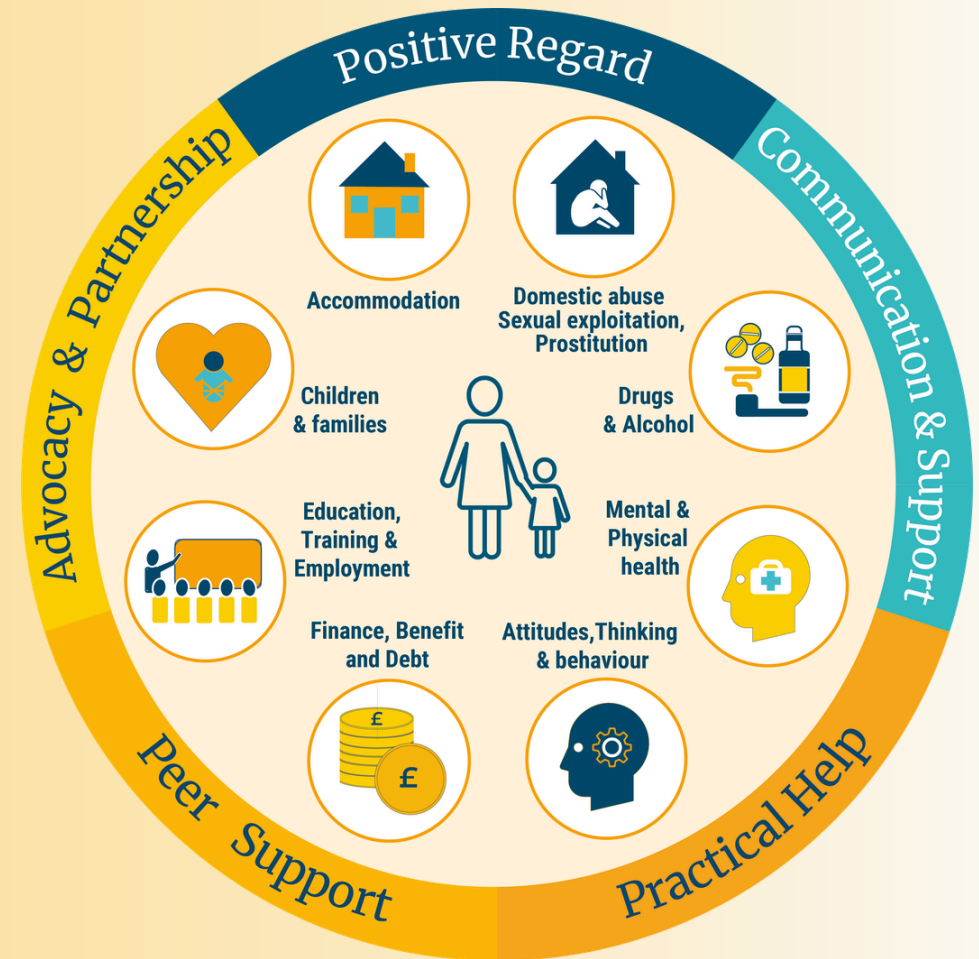
- Targeted support and advocacy for women to address practical and emotional needs, including outreach services
